

PLEASE NOTE

Principals must submit a school calendar that includes (at least) 180 days in 2017 -18 to provide Common Core Professional Development, 175 instructional days and 5 conference days; one conference day is to focus on religious education. 13 half days for professional development and/or faculty meetings are the maximum number allowed during the school year. The graduation date for eighth grade classes should be no earlier than one week prior to the last day of school.

VARIANCES FROM THE SUPERINTENDENT'S CALENDAR

Elementary schools seeking a variance must contact their Regional Superintendent at least 10 days in advance and must include the date(s) on which the lost instruction time will be made up.

BUSING NOTICE: SCHOOLS IN NEW YORK CITY ONLY

Under current law, this year our schools will get busing for two days when the NYC public schools are not in session. The law specifies these days as Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of New York follow the policy of local public schools when closing due to inclement weather, loss of power or other issues.

In addition to following the lead of New York City public schools, Catholic schools in Staten Island, the Bronx and Manhattan may find it necessary to make closure decisions independently, based on local situations.

Schools in Westchester, Putnam and the Upper Counties that rely on public school districts for bus transportation will follow the delayed opening or closing policy of the local district.
